You will develop your professional carpentry skills to observe, analyse and evaluate various building operations and processes **as if you were the Carpenter running the project.**

Course Duration

This popular course structure is delivered in two parts:

- Part 1: Three (3) days a week for a thirty six (36) weeks at our simulated workplace centres
- Part 2: Work for eight-hundred (800) hours or more for a carpentry/building company as a carpenter on actual jobsites.
