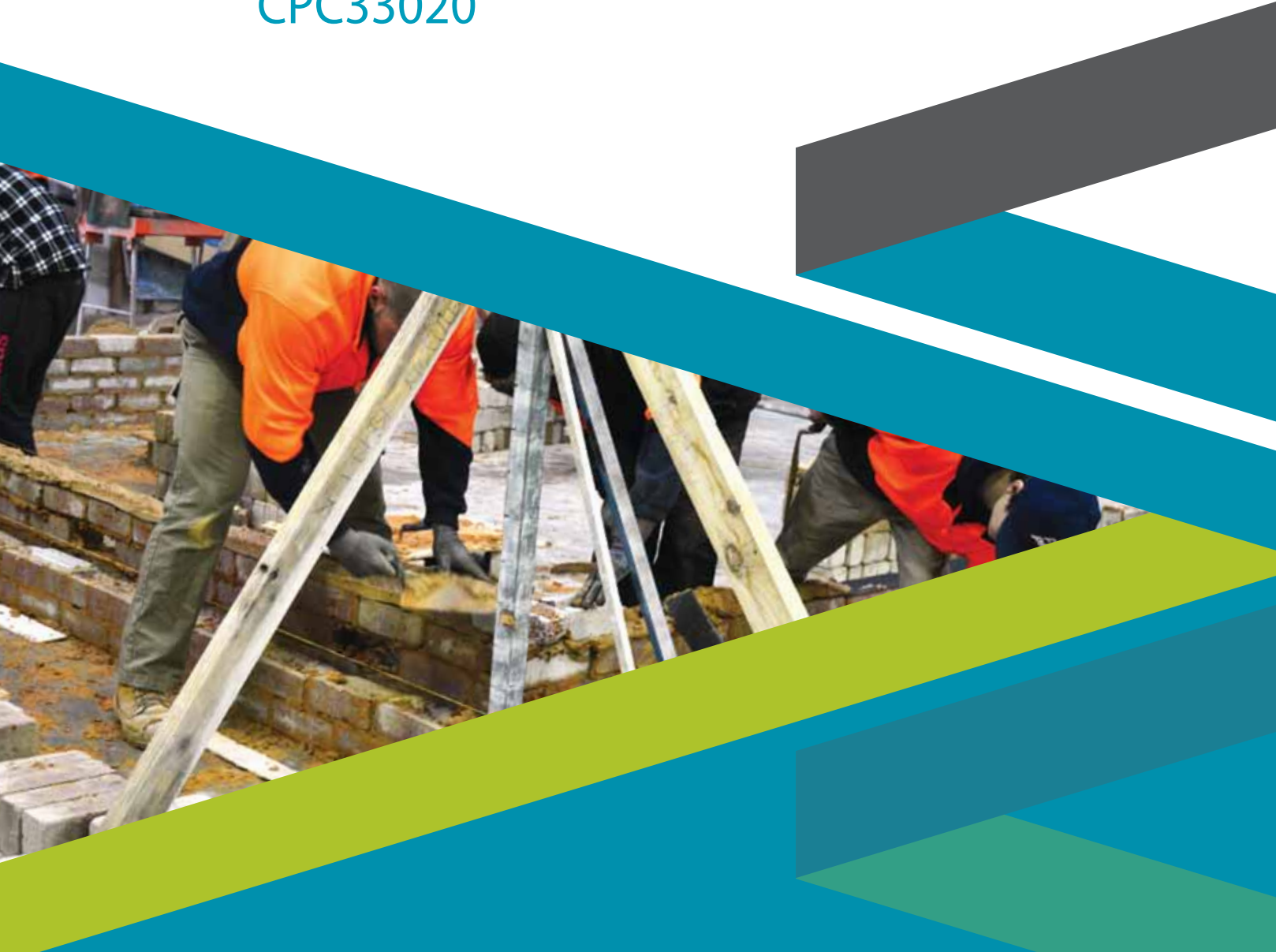




Certificate III in Bricklaying and Blocklaying CPC33020

The CPCC33020 - Certificate III in Bricklaying and Blocklaying qualification is ideal for both men and women who intend to pursue a career as a Bricklayer/Blocklayer through an Apprenticeship.

As an Apprentice, you will develop your professional bricklaying and blocklaying skills including skills to observe, analyse, evaluate and undertake bricklaying projects **as if you were the Bricklayer/ Blocklayer**.

Course Duration

Typically, this Apprenticeship will take three (3) years to completion; less if you show you are acquiring all the necessary skills and knowledge in a shorter time frame.

The majority of your training will occur in the workplace, overseen by your employer and assessed by TIV's qualified Assessors. In addition, you will also attend TIV's Trade School two (2) days per month over ten (10) months of the year to ensure you have a well-rounded experience of bricklaying, particularly in providing opportunities to practice skills that may not be available in your workplace.
